#### The Curse of the Mummy: Uncovering Tutankhamun's Tomb written by Candace Fleming

This book is the true story of the search for Tutankhamun's tomb, the Western public's belief that the dig was cursed, and the battle for ownership of the treasures within.

Every Magnet student is required to complete <u>one</u> of the following assignments in English class once school starts. Your English teacher will explain the assignment expectations and provide a rubric prior to completing the assignment. It is recommended that students wait to receive specific instruction from their teacher prior to completing the assignment as changes may be made.

# 6th Grade Options (Choose one assignment to complete)

- A. Use a small box like a shoe box to create a diorama of a major or important scene from the novel. Be able to explain.
- B. Create a flier announcing your book as a blockbuster movie coming soon to theaters. On your flier include the title of the book and tell who will play the roles of your main characters (use real actors and famous people of today). On your flier write at least two movie reviews that tell the most exciting parts of your book/coming movie.
- C. Make a mobile or digital presentation showing pictures or symbols of happenings in the book. (at least 5 pictures with detailed explanations of what the symbol represents and how it is significant to the story)

# 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Options (Choose one assignment to complete)

- A. Write a letter from one character to another character. (3 paragraphs in letter format; include the parts of a letter)
- B. Make a hand written or digital comic strip of your story (Make sure to include major plot developments in the story). Must have 8 frames and a title.
- C. Create a radio ad for your book. Write out the script and record an audio of your ad as it would be heard on the radio. Don't forget appropriate background music! (2 minutes minimum)

# 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Options (Choose one assignment to complete)

- A. Write a Literary Analysis (must be 12 point font typed with an introduction, 2 body paragraphs on Plot Elements & Theme, and a conclusion; length may vary).
- B. Write a Book Review and Recommendation (must be at least 1 page in length).
- C. Prepare a list of 15 to 20 questions for use in determining if other people have read the book carefully. At least 5 questions true and false, 5 multiple choice and 5 short answer essay questions and the answers must be provided using complete sentences.
