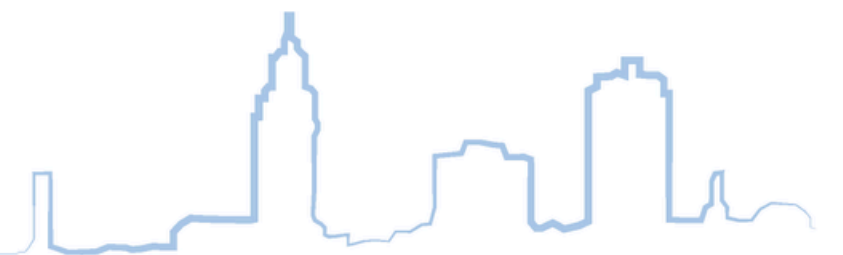
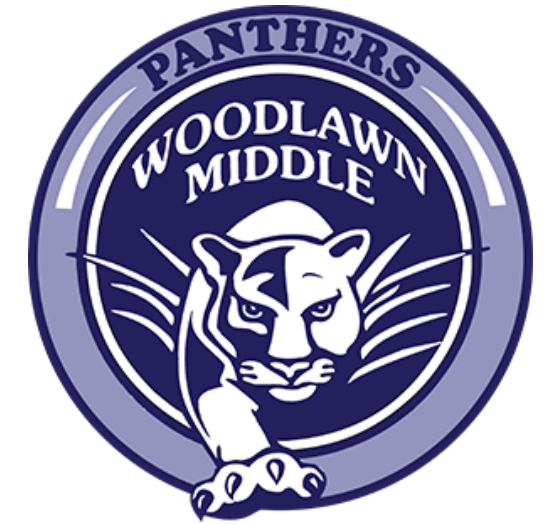
WMS MISSION

Sacrifice

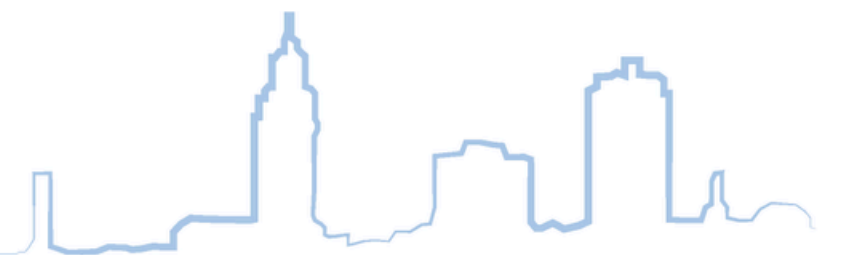
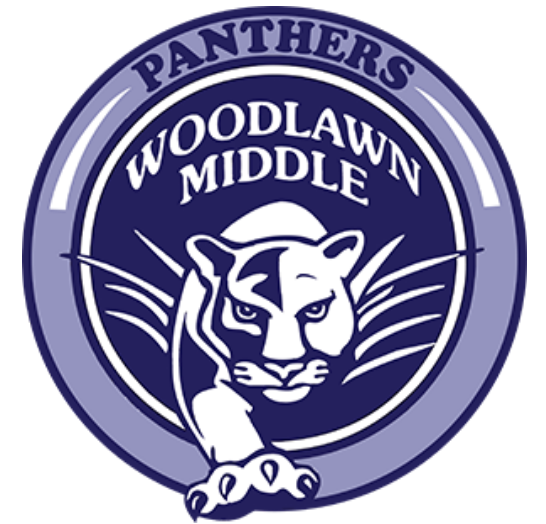

SAFETY

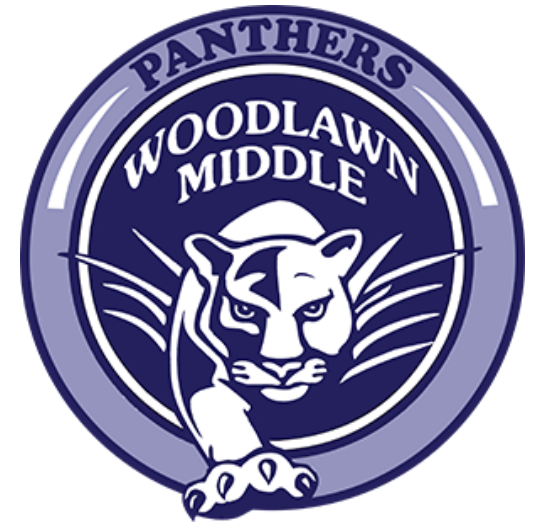

Crisis planning is necessary to ensure the safety of everyone.



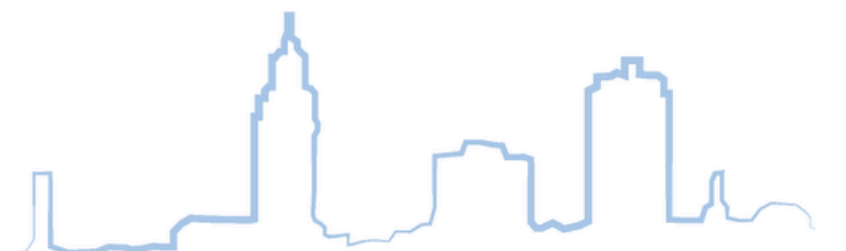
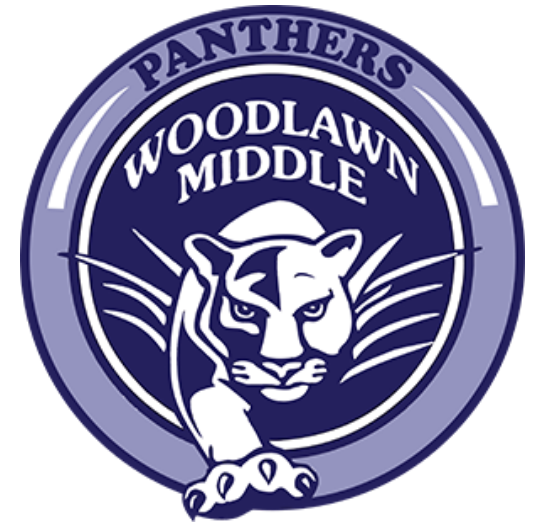

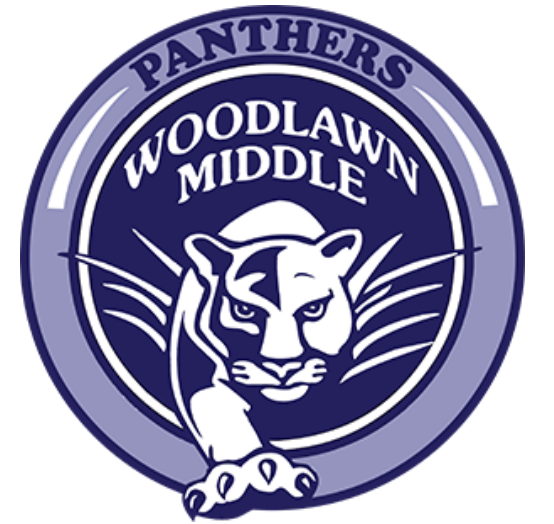

- There is no substitute for lost instructional time.



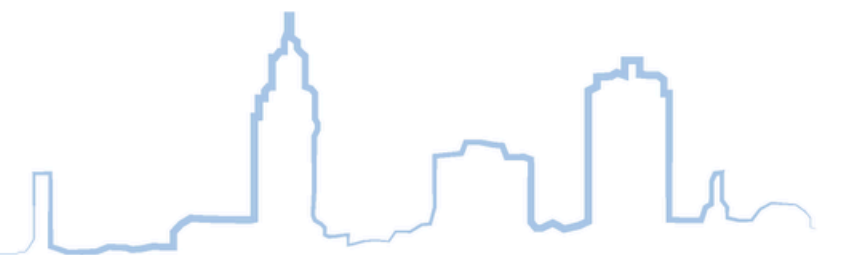

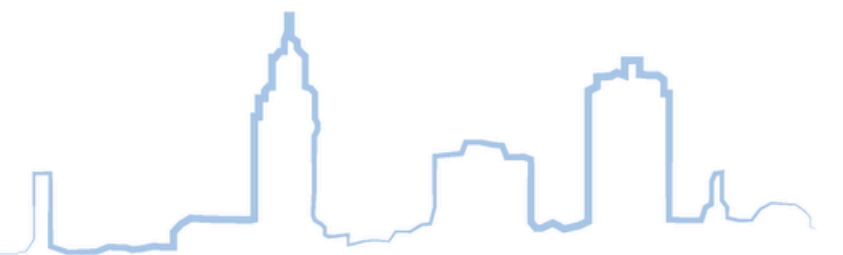


DRESS CODE

Solid white undershirts with sleeves that should not be longer than sleeves of uniform shirt must be worn.

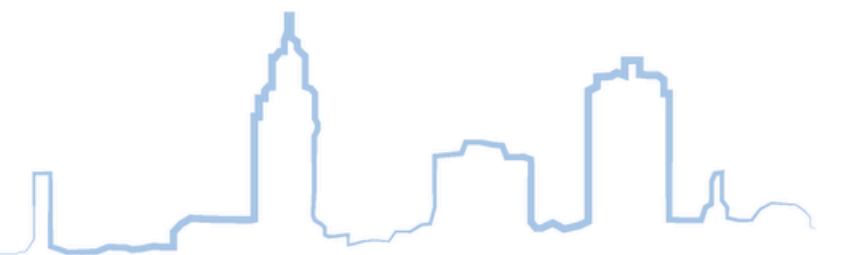
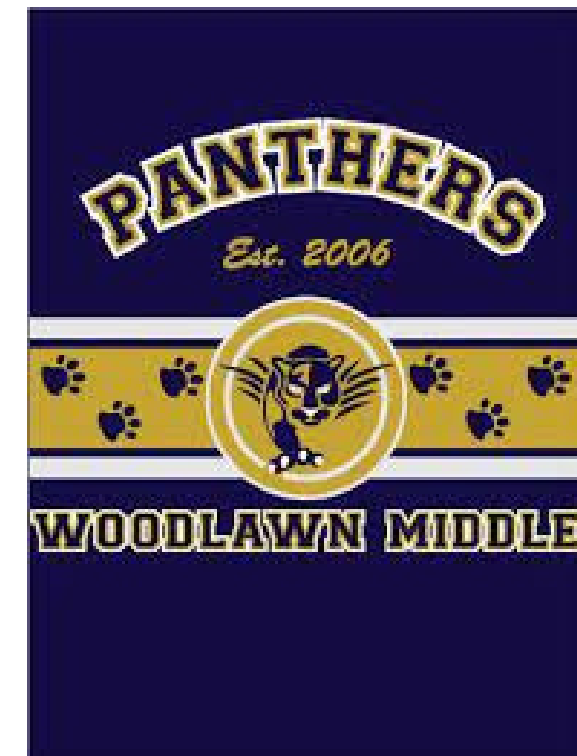


DRESS CODE

Woodlawn Middle School's Official Purple Sweatshirt or Other Official Woodlawn Middle School Sweatshirt may be worn.

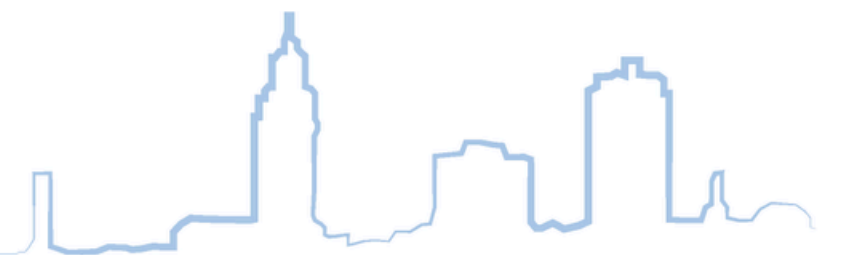
Plain brown, black, blue, navy blue, white or khaki belts must be worn.

NO DESIGNS/DECORATIONS, rivets, holes, jewels/stones, or embroidery is allowed on belts.



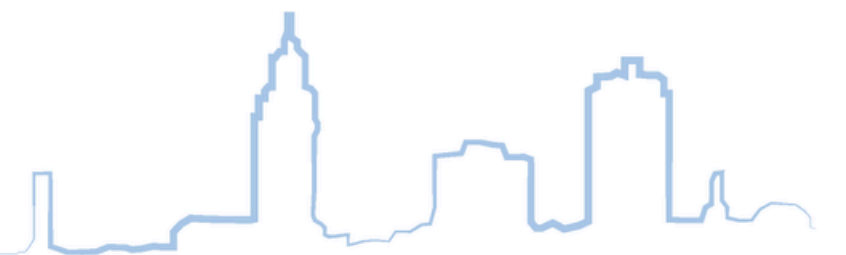
BACKPACKS

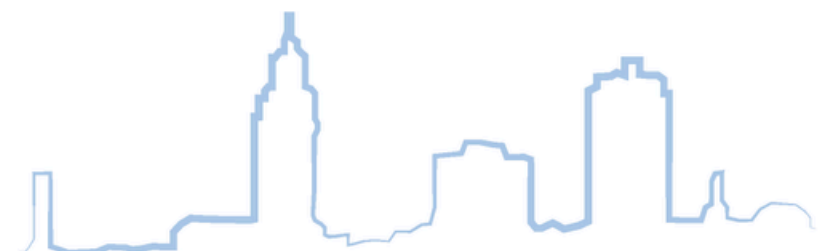

START TIME

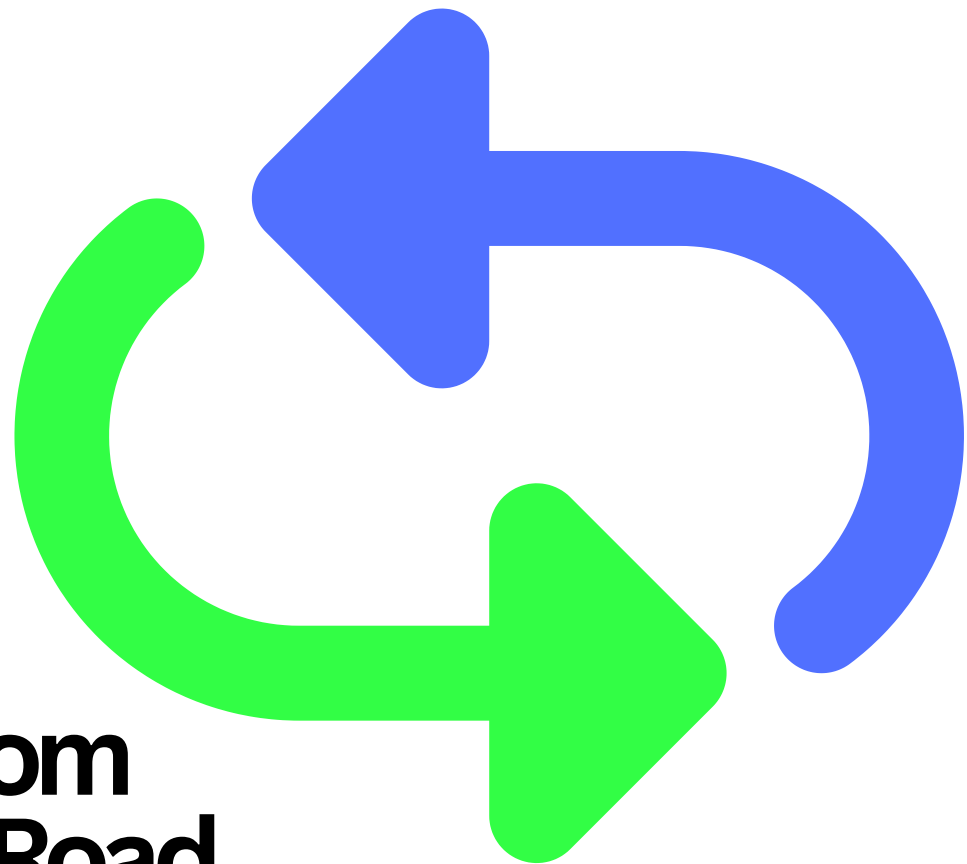
Students are allowed to enter the building as early as 6:45 am.

The tardy bells rings at 7:10 am. Any student entering the building after 7:10 am, but before 7:30 am must enter the attendance office to check in.

After 7:30 am parents must escort their child to the attendance office to be SIGNED in.

6th grade and multiple passenger carpool will enter the carpool lane from Tiger Bend Road



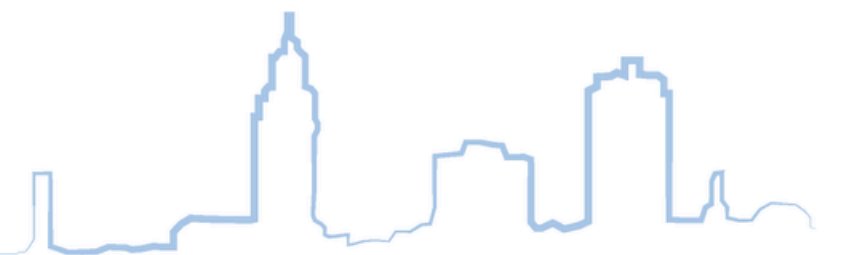

Parents may not check out students after 2:00PM

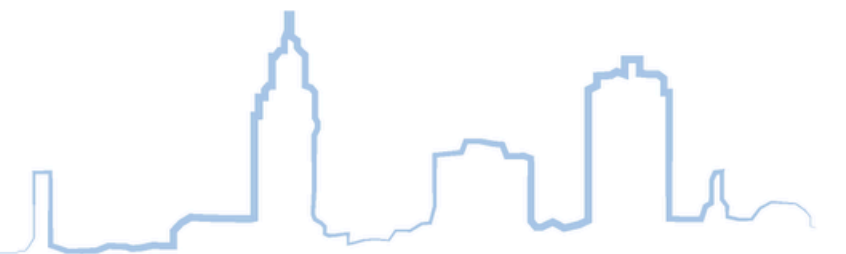
