Dear Parents and Guardians:

East Baton Rouge Parish School System (EBRPSS) is committed to supporting all students' well-being. As a part of these efforts, we incorporate social-emotional learning (SEL) and instructional practices to promote student well-being throughout the school day. Each year we assess student perceptions of their own social and emotional well-being through a self-assessment. This year the WCSD-SEL assessment will be utilized. This 17-question tool measures students in five areas: Self Awareness, Social Awareness, Self Management, Responsible Decision Making, and Relationship Skills. School staff will use the assessment to identify the strengths and needs of students in grades 3-12.

In addition to measuring these skill areas, the self-assessment will review students' feelings of belonging and their feelings about the school environment. These factors are critical to positive academic, social, and emotional success.

All students in grades 3-12 will participate in the assessment twice a year, in the fall and spring. This data will only be accessible to teachers, administrators, and staff with legitimate educational interests. Results will be maintained in secure files and databases accessible only to these individuals. Assessment results will be used with other data to inform practices for life skill development. Assessment data will also help staff plan interventions for students with identified needs.

Schools will administer the SEL assessment from August 26 to September 13 and March 1-30. If you have concerns about the Student Self Assessment, please contact your school counselor.

## Evaluación del aprendizaje social y emocional (SEL)

Estimados padres y tutores:

El Sistema Escolar Parroquial de East Baton Rouge (EBRPSS) está comprometido a apoyar el bienestar de todos los estudiantes. Como parte de estos esfuerzos, incorporamos aprendizaje socioemocional (SEL) y prácticas de instrucción para promover el bienestar de los estudiantes durante la jornada escolar. Cada año evaluamos las percepciones de los estudiantes sobre su propio bienestar social y emocional a través de una autoevaluación. Este año se utilizará la evaluación WCSD-SEL. Esta 17 pregunta La herramienta mide a los estudiantes en 5 áreas: autoconciencia, conciencia social, autogestión, toma de decisiones responsable y habilidades para relacionarse. El personal de la escuela utilizará la evaluación para identificar las fortalezas y necesidades de los estudiantes en los grados 3-12.

Además de medir estas áreas de habilidades, la autoevaluación revisará los sentimientos de pertenencia de los estudiantes y sus sentimientos sobre el ambiente escolar. Estos factores son fundamentales para el éxito académico, social y emocional positivo.

Todos los estudiantes en los grados 3-12 participarán en la evaluación dos veces al año, en otoño y primavera. Estos datos solo serán accesibles para profesores, administradores y personal con intereses educativos legítimos. Los resultados se mantendrán en archivos y bases de datos seguros a los que solo podrán acceder estas personas. Los resultados de la evaluación se utilizarán con otros datos para informar las prácticas para el desarrollo de habilidades para la vida. Los datos de las evaluaciones también ayudarán al personal a planificar intervenciones para los estudiantes con necesidades identificadas.

Las escuelas administrarán la evaluación SEL del 26 de agosto al 13 de septiembre y del 1 al 30 de marzo. Si tiene dudas sobre la autoevaluación del estudiante, comuníquese con su consejero escolar.
